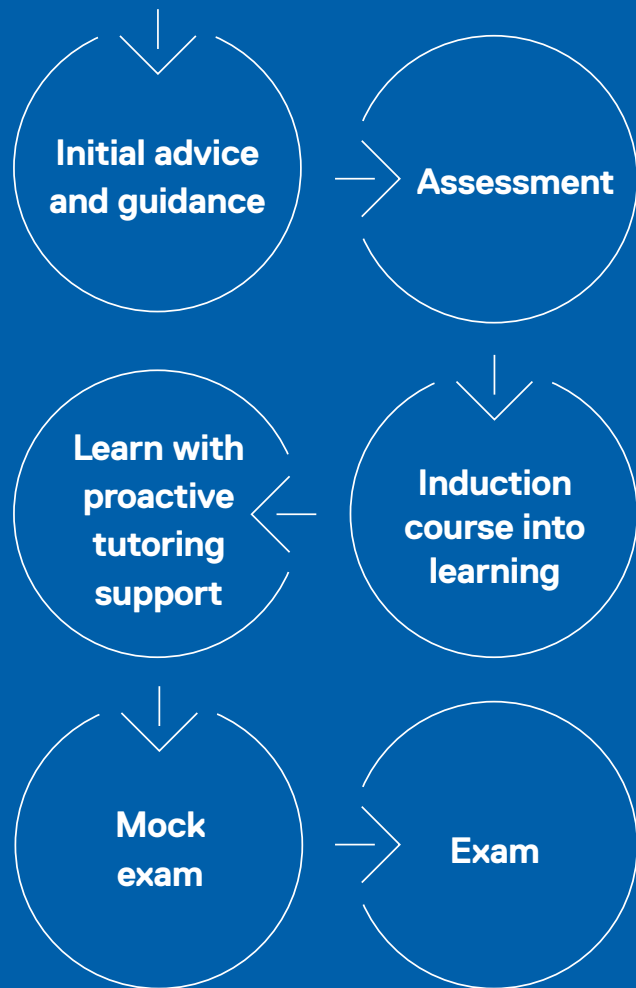

COSTS

These prices cover the learning resource pack and proactive tutor support by distance learning, plus exam entry fee and arrangements to sit at sea if appropriate.
